# History of the Tigers 100 Club

In 1982, the Club looked to secure the support of former players – many of whom had disappeared from the scene with little or no contact with their former club. The following is a sequence of events:

- The Tigers 100 Club was formed to initiate/renew support from former players. When the 100 Club was being formed the Tigers did not have licensed premises.
- The inaugural meeting of the 100 Club was held at the Queanbeyan Bowling Club in August of 1982 and attracted 25 of the 44 players who had played 100 First Grade games for the club.
- It was a nostalgic evening, attracting a tremendous gathering of past and present players.
- It is believed that the formation of the Tigers 100 Club was a first for any sporting body within the district, recognising player achievement(s) by way of an annual dinner.

# The 100 Club was the catalyst for the Tigers to develop an organisation within the football club that would provide players with an incentive and opportunity to have their names entrenched in the Club's history.

The 100 Club meets annually and admits new members as they reach the 100 First Grade milestone. The highlight of the gathering each year is the attendance of former players who participated in past decades. As the years pass, those who represented the club in the 1930s, 1940s, 1950s & 1960s have become scarcer as our older generation decline. Players from the 1970s to present day continue the legacy of the 100 Club.

The 100 Club has expanded to incorporate other categories, it allows the football club the opportunity to recognise outstanding achievements by individuals within the organisation. The 100 Club recognises:

#### 100 First Grade Games (Full Membership)

Recognise players that have played 100 First Grade games.

#### **Associate Playing Member**

Recognise players who have participated in 100 games for the club being a total of First and Reserve Grade matches. This membership also recognises players who have played 100 AFL Canberra 1<sup>st</sup> Grade games that are a combination of the Tigers and any previous club total games.

#### Associate Official

Recognise the outstanding contribution made by individuals from within the organisation in a voluntary capacity.

The 100 Club Dinner also provides the opportunity to recognise other outstanding contributions and milestones within the organisation. These contributions / milestones include:

• Presentation of Life Memberships for services rendered at Board level of the Licensed Club or to the Football organisation.

- Inductions to the Tigers Wall of Fame and Walk of Honour.
- Recognition of other playing milestones, including 150 / 200 / 250 / 300 First Grade or Club Games.
- Premiership Reunions.
- Elevation of Wall of Fame recipients to Legend status.

Wall of Fame

The Tigers Wall of Fame was also a first in the district and is widely acclaimed by many sporting organisations.

The initial Wall of Fame inductees were drawn from a wide spectrum of individuals all of whom provided the Tigers with outstanding service to the organisation or by way of an outstanding achievement.

At least two individuals were included from each decade in the initial Wall of Fame opened in 1987.

The inclusion of a person on the Tigers Wall of Fame normally occurs either from the milestone of playing 200 Men's 1st Grade or Club games & 150 Women's 1st Grade or Club Games: or for outstanding achievement whether on the playing field, as an administrator or as a volunteer.

Admittance to the Wall of Fame for an outstanding achievement is based on the historical value of the individual's contribution and achievement. The Tigers Football Operations has a sub committee to review all achievements within the organisation and subsequently decide on new inclusions.

Like the Tigers Wall of Fame, the Walk of Honour was also a first in the district. It is also widely acclaimed by many sporting organisations.

The Walk of Honour was created to recognise the tragic loss of Michael Haddock who was taken from us on Christmas Eve 2004. His family, in conjunction with the Club and the Queanbeyan City Council, provided a pathway from the top car park at Aulich Park to the grandstand.

The path is adorned with plaques honouring those who have played **200 Men's** 1st Grade or Club games & **150 Women's** 1<sup>st</sup> Grade or Club Games.

The Club has also introduced Legend status for those who have served the organisation in a manner regarded as outstanding. Legends are also honoured with plaques along the Walk of Honour.

Criteria for elevation to Legend status includes being on the Wall of Fame.

The first elevation to Legend status took place on the 29th anniversary of the Tigers 100 Club function - 2011. The recipient was none other than legendary Team Manager Noel Miller whose team management spans the period 1977 to 2019.

The second elevation took place at the club's 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Dinner in 2014 when true legend, Alan Muir was elevated.

The third elevation took place at the club's 100 Club Function in 2019 when tigers heart and soul, Ron Fowlie was elevated.






