

In 1966 club funds were still in a dire position. At a meeting early in 1966 a vote was held with those in attendance in favour of amalgamating the Queanbeyan and Turner clubs as both lacked playing numbers.

At a 'meet the coach' evening, 70-80 players attended with much discussion around the name of the senior team. "Cuties" (as in Q-T's) was originally mentioned, and an alternative name of "The Turkeys" was suggested.

The final consensus was "The Cats" with colours of navy blue and white hoops with a gold Q.



The team had some reasonable players however could not match the stronger ACT clubs and were repeatedly defeated by large margins over the year, and only winning 2 matches. At the end of the season the club again made headlines as the Club President was resigning, however with a warning that without support the club might fold, a special meeting brought together 30+ people with much enthusiasm for the next season.

The amalgamation remained in place until 1969 when many of the Queanbeyan juniors moved up into the senior club and gave the club hope for a self supporting future.



Annual Muir Medal

This weekend sees the playing of the 18th Annual Muir Medal.

The Muir Medal was introduced in 2006 following the passing of Tigers Legend Alan Muir. The Medal recognises the significant contribution of Alan to the Tigers and his son Ian to Ainslie.

Alan provided 60 years' service to the Tigers as a player/official and passionate supporter. His legacy is recognised by all players with his "Eat Em Alive" signature.

lan continues to provide the same service to the Ainslie Football Club as his late father did to the Tigers as a player & official.

The Muir Medal is played for once a year, at alternate grounds and voted by former players of the two clubs along with a League Representative.
